- **Pastor's Report Highlights (complete report included with the minutes)**
 - Father Jeff reported that while collections are up since the Financial Report, we are still below our anticipated budget. Good news is at this point our expenses are under budget. Part of the low expenses is not having entered the heating season yet.
 - The Christmas letter has been sent out. There has not been a lot of feedback. The Council supports the letter and appreciates having it sent out to the members of our parish.
 - Father has placed a Facebook ad for our Christmas Masses. It has already received some "likes" and will serve to promote communication in our community
 - Changes in announcing birthdays/anniversaries have been positively received.
 - Father reported our progress in meeting our CMA goal
- **Regional Planning Meeting in Clyde**
 - Prior to this council meeting Father emailed the materials presented at the Regional Meeting to members of the Council
 - Father and Council members who attended the meeting provided insight and feedback from the meeting. It is clear

that changes are necessary. Careful planning, consideration and prayerful thought will be necessary to effectively manage the anticipated change.

- We reviewed and discussed the geographic parameters and challenges for parishes in Wayne County. We have a relatively large geographic area, but not a densely populated area.
- We anticipate going from 5 priests in Wayne County to 4 in the next five years.
- The next meeting will likely be at the end of January, 2018
- Carmella will be the Pastoral Council representative. A representative from the Financial Committee has yet to be determined.
- **Old Business**

 - Greeters. We discussed the benefit of have Greeters at each mass. We were encouraged to check the schedule that was distributed to all Council members. It was suggested that the Greeters could be included in the bulletin schedule.
